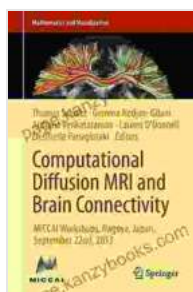

Transportation

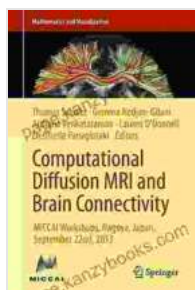
